Principal's Report

Enrolment Policy Discussion

The NPS enrolment policy currently caps student numbers at 20 per class, or a total of 40. 2019 already has 39 students allocated.

The school needs at least 53 students before more teachers and resources are allocated, other than \$50 per student.

If the numbers drop to 25 or less the school loses a teacher.

The question is, do we accept more students and grow the school knowing over the next few years it means a greater student per teacher ratio or do we keep it capped at 40 and develop a waiting list for students wanting to attend the exclusive boutique NPS?

The policy is revised each year. Most parents at the meeting want to keep the school capped at 40.

Vote Uniforms

New sports shirt voted for and **ACCEPTED** at 60% cotton and 40% polyester And a new everyday shirt uniform was also accepted on the principle it was more cotton than polyester than the current shirt.

A discussion was had about healthy lunches.
