Stay at home when unwell

Students are expected to stay away from school when unwell. Please notify the school if your child is unwell with any cold and flu symptoms, including coughs, sniffles, sneezing, high temperatures. Students should only return when fully recovered, with no symptoms.

Illness

If students are away from school because they are unwell, there is no expectation that they complete school work. It is important that unwell students rest.

Wash your hands regularly and thoroughly

Students are reminded and given time to wash hands every time they leave and enter the room and after using shared equipment. These routines are becoming habitual for all students.

Visitors on School Grounds

Non-essential adults, including parents and carers, are still not permitted on school grounds or at school events. P&C meetings should continue online. P&C run activities involving gatherings should continue to be discouraged to minimise the number of non-essential adults on the school site.
