Student Accounts

Student accounts will be sent home this week unless students have fees in advance; then these funds will be used for book packs. Book Pack fees remain at \$50 per student this year plus \$10 for head phones for Kindergarten and new students. Book pack fees supply and replenish the stationary your child uses throughout the year, eg books, reading folders, pencils, whiteboard markers, glue, etc. Each child has their own materials kept in their pencil case. Book Pack fees can be paid for using your child's 'Fees in Advance' (FIA). For those families with no FIA, payment can be made via POP on our school website, or by bringing cash to the office. We do not have EFTPOS facilities.

Voluntary Contributions are also remaining at \$50 per student this year. Voluntary Contributions are used for art and craft supplies and materials so that we are able to offer a range of activities Our first P&C meeting of the year will be at 5:30 pm throughout the year. Voluntary Contribution fees are voluntary.

Fees In Advance

A lot of parents still have funds available to use in their child's 'Fees in Advance' from the flood hardship fund issued by the Department last year. These funds are only available to use until the end of this year. Funds can be shared by siblings. Fees can be used for Book packs, uniforms, excursions, PSSA sport and school photographs. Balances will show on your child's Student Accounts. If you have any questions, please speak to Maureen in the office.

Please ensure your child has a hat with their name clearly on it every day. Hats are available to purchase from the office if your child needs a new one.

Service NSW vouchers

Service NSW offers parents and carers of all children aged 4.5 - 18 years who have a current Medicare card and are enrolled in school from Kindergarten to Year 12, two \$100 Active Kids and one \$100 Creative Kids vouchers per calendar year. These can be used for many different activities outside of school. In addition, parents and carers can also apply for a one off Back to School voucher of \$150 (3 x \$50 vouchers) that can be used at registered businesses to help families pay for any school supplies.
