The K-1 class have been learning to recognise and create patterns. We made number, colour and shape patterns. We also created patterns in nature.



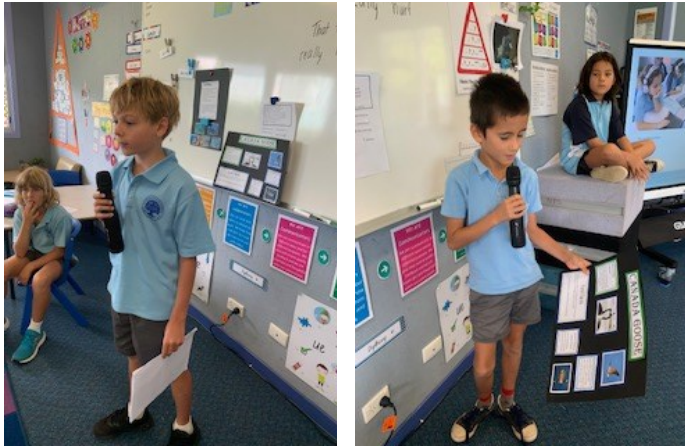
Play-based Learning

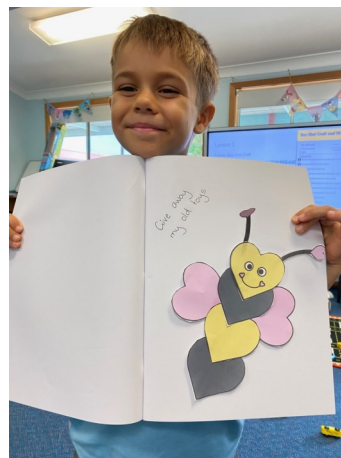

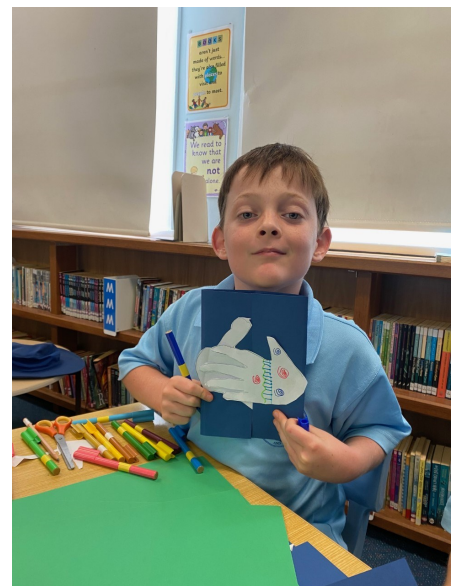
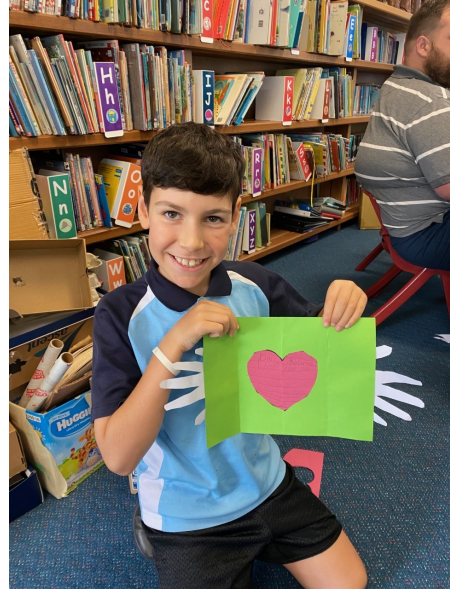
